

OLD TESTAMENT

Beginnings - Genesis 1:1

¹In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.

Love God - Deuteronomy 6:4-5

⁴Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God is one LORD: ⁵and thou shalt love the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might.

Word of God - Joshua 1:8-9

⁸This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt meditate therein day and night, that thou mayest observe to do according to all that is written therein: for then thou shalt make thy way prosperous, and then thou shalt have good success. ⁹Have not I commanded thee? Be strong and of a good courage; be not afraid, neither be thou dismayed: for the LORD thy God is with thee whithersoever thou goest.

Humility Before God - II Chronicles 7:13-14

¹³If I shut up heaven that there be no rain, or if I command the locusts to devour the land, or if I send pestilence among my people; ¹⁴if my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.

God's Glory in Creation - Psalm 19:1

¹The heavens declare the glory of God; and the firmament sheweth his handywork.

Godly Thinking & Speech - Psalm 19:14

¹⁴Let the words of my mouth, and the meditation of my heart, be acceptable in thy sight, O LORD, my strength, and my redeemer.

The Shepherd's Psalm - Psalm 23:1-6

¹The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want. ²He maketh me to lie down in green pastures: he leadeth me beside the still waters. ³He restoreth my soul: he leadeth me in the paths of righteousness for his name's sake. ⁴Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil: for thou art with me; thy rod and thy staff they comfort me. ⁵Thou preparest a table before me in the presence of mine enemies: thou anointest my head with oil; my cup runneth over. ⁶Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life: and I will dwell in the house of the LORD for ever.

Trusting God: Courage - Psalm 27:1

¹The LORD is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? the LORD is the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?

Trusting God: Courage - Psalm 56:3-4

³What time I am afraid, I will trust in thee. ⁴In God I will praise his word, in God I have put my trust; I will not fear what flesh can do unto me.

God - Psalm 86:15

¹⁵But thou, O Lord, art a God full of compassion, and gracious, longsuffering, and plenteous in mercy and truth.

Worship & Thanksgiving - Psalm 100:1-5

¹Make a joyful noise unto the LORD, all ye lands. ²Serve the LORD with gladness: come before his presence with singing. ³Know ye that the LORD he is God: it is he that hath made us, and not we ourselves; we are his people, and the sheep of his pasture. ⁴Enter into his gates with thanksgiving, and into his courts with praise: be thankful unto him, and bless his name. ⁵For the LORD is good; his mercy is everlasting; and his truth endureth to all generations.

Joy - Psalm 118:24

²⁴This is the day which the LORD hath made; we will rejoice and be glad in it.

God's Word - Psalm 119:11

¹¹Thy word have I hid in mine heart, that I might not sin against thee.

Godly Speech - Psalm 141:3

³Set a watch, O LORD, before my mouth; keep the door of my lips.

☐ Wisdom - Proverbs 1:7

⁷The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge: but fools despise wisdom and instruction.

³Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on thee: because he trusteth in thee. ⁴Trust ye in the LORD for ever: for in the LORD JEHOVAH is everlasting strength:

God's Promise - Matthew 6:33

³³But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.

Love God & Love Others - Matthew 22:37-39

³⁷Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind. ³⁸This is the first and great commandment. ³⁹And the second is like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.

How to Treat Others - Luke 6:27 & 31

²⁷But I say unto you which hear, Love your enemies, do good to them which hate you, ³¹And as ye would that men should do to you, do ye also to them likewise.

^{10b}I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly. ¹¹I am the good shepherd: the good shepherd giveth his life for the sheep.

God's Promise - John 14:1-3

¹Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in God, believe also in me. ²In my Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. ³And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also.

Jesus & Salvation - John 14:6

⁶Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.

God's Peace - John 14:27

²⁷Peace I leave with you, my peace I give unto you: not as the world giveth, give I unto you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.

God's Faithfulness - I Corinthians 10:13

¹³There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but God is faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear it.

Salvation - Romans 3:23

²³for all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;

Salvation - Romans 5:8

⁸But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

Salvation - Romans 6:23

²³For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

²⁸And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose.

⁹that if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. ¹⁰For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

☐ Godly Living - Romans 12:1-2

¹I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. ²And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

☐ Godly Living - I Corinthians 10:31

³¹Whether therefore ye eat, or drink, or whatsoever ye do, do all to the glory of God.

☐ Godly Living - I Corinthians 14:40

⁴⁰Let all things be done decently and in order.

☐ Victorious Living - I Corinthians 15:57

⁵⁷But thanks be to God, which giveth us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.

☐ Godly Living - I Corinthians 15:58

⁵⁸Therefore, my beloved brethren, be ye stedfast, unmoveable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, forasmuch as ye know that your labour is not in vain in the Lord.

☐ New Life in Christ - II Corinthians 5:17

¹⁷Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.

☐ New Life in Christ - Galatians 2:20

²⁰I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me.

☐ Evidence of the Holy Spirit - Galatians 5:22-23

²²But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, ²³meekness, temperance: against such there is no law.

☐ Faith - Ephesians 2:8-9

⁸For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: ⁹not of works, lest any man should boast.

☐ Godly Speech - Ephesians 4:29

²⁹Let no corrupt communication proceed out of your mouth, but that which is good to the use of edifying, that it may minister grace unto the hearers.

☐ Godly Speech & Actions - Ephesians 4:31-32

³¹Let all bitterness, and wrath, and anger, and clamour, and evil speaking, be put away from you, with all malice: ³²and be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you.

☐ God's Protection - Ephesians 6:10-11

¹⁰Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might. ¹¹Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.

☐ Godly Speech & Actions - Philippians 2:14

¹⁴Do all things without murmurings and disputings:

☐ Joy, Prayer & Peace - Philippians 4:4-7

⁴Rejoice in the Lord alway: and again I say, Rejoice. ⁵Let your moderation be known unto all men. The Lord is at hand. ⁶Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God. ⁷And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

☐ God's Power in Me - Philippians 4:13

¹³I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me.

☐ Peace, Wisdom & Diligence - Colossians 3:15-17

¹⁵And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to the which also ye are called in one body; and be ye thankful. ¹⁶Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom; teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord. ¹⁷And whatsoever ye do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God and the Father by him.

☐ Joy, Prayer & God's Will - I Thessalonians 5:16-18

¹⁶Rejoice evermore. ¹⁷Pray without ceasing. ¹⁸In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you.

☐ God's Promise - II Timothy 1:7

⁷For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.

☐ Purpose & Power of God's Word - II Timothy 3:16-17

¹⁶All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: ¹⁷that the man of God may be perfect, throughly furnished unto all good works.

☐ Purpose & Power of God's Word - Hebrews 4:12

¹²For the word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

☐ Faith - Hebrews 11:6

⁶But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.

☐ Living With Security & Without Fear - Hebrews 13:5b-6

^{5b}and be content with such things as ye have: for he hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee. ⁶So that we may boldly say, The Lord is my helper, and I will not fear what man shall do unto me.

☐ Wisdom - James 1:5

⁵If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all men liberally, and upbraideth not; and it shall be given him.

☐ Godly Living - James 1:22

²²But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves.

☐ Grace & Humility - James 4:6

⁶But he giveth more grace. Wherefore he saith, God resisteth the proud, but giveth grace unto the humble.

☐ Our Humility & God's Care - I Peter 5:6-7

⁶Humble yourselves therefore under the mighty hand of God, that he may exalt you in due time: ⁷casting all your care upon him; for he careth for you.

☐ Forgiveness - I John 1:9

⁹If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

¹⁹We love him, because he first loved us.
